New Beginnings

I'm getting excited about all of the new things God is doing in our church. In the next week we will begin several new ministries, and I want to invite you to participate in each of these new beginnings.

August 23 is our Bring A Friend Sunday, and I know so many of you have been praying for the people you know who do not have a church home. I hope you will step out in faith to invite those friends and family members to come to worship with you as we begin a sermon series called *Overloaded* in which we will take a closer look at the circumstances that cause our lives to be so busy. We will also examine some of the principles in the Bible that can help us to find a healthier rhythm for our lives.

That evening we will host a **Block Party** from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. on the south end of the church's property at 1212 Bedford Drive in Nichols Hills. The Block Party will include hot dogs, homemade ice cream, music, games, a giant Slip-N-Slide, water games, inflatables, and fun for all ages. It is not too late to sign up to help with the Block Party, and I hope you will come and enjoy a fun evening as we make new friends and grow closer as together.

Nichols Thrills will begin on Wednesday, August 26 at 5:30 with a Fellowship Meal. I will be teaming up with our church staff to provide the meal that night. We will have hickory smoked pulled pork, picnic potatoes, red slaw, hushpuppies, brownies, and cookies. We will be inviting Sunday school classes and small groups to sign up to provide one of the meals during the fall semester. You can really get to know people when you cook together.

Then, at 6:00 p.m. we will offer small groups for children, youth, and adults.

Our Children's Small Group will be called Expedition and will meet in the room across from the Parlor which we have named Creation Station. If you would like to help with our Children and Family Ministry, please contact Lauren Matthes. Sign up your child in the church office to be part of this exciting new ministry.

Adults and youth will have the opportunity to participate in the Alpha Course which is an opportunity for anyone to explore spirituality from a Christian perspective. Relaxed, non-threatening, low-key, and fun, Alpha is a place to ask anything—no question is considered too simple or too hostile. Alpha guests share meals, listen to a series of talks, and then have small group discussion. Each talk covers a fundamental question like, Who is Jesus?, Why did Jesus Die?, and Does God Heal Today? Our hope is that Alpha will help our church reach out to the Nichols Hills community and let people know that Nichols Hills United Methodist Church is a church where they can bring their questions about Jesus and the Christian faith. It is a way that we can invite people to learn about God and become part of our congregation. You can sign up to be part of the Alpha Course in the church office.

I am so grateful to be part of the new things God is doing in our church, and I invite you to come and share in God's blessings as we experience these new beginnings.
